Eligibility Inquiries	 Providers should ask for the State of Alaska Medicaid Identification Card, this card will have a Medicaid Eligibility Identification number starting with either "06" or "20". The Medicaid Card will either say "DenaliCare" or "Denali KidCare." If the individual has a large paper coupon, this is not full Medicaid coverage and either indicates that the individual has their Medicare Part A and B paid for by State of Alaska Medicaid, or the individuals is in the Care Management program. When someone shows a large paper coupon, the provider should always check eligibility using the link on the Optum Alaska website. 	
Payment Amounts	Alaska Medicaid is Fee-for-Service and Optum will conduct utilization review and payment of services based on State regulation and established State Fee Schedules.

Later in 2020, providers submitted claims to Optum for State Plan Community Behavioral Health Services (CBHS), Mental Health Physician Clinics (MHPC), Autism Services, independently enrolled Psychologists, Acute Psychiatric Hospitals and Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF) services.
